

**FIM MotoGP Stewards Panel**

**NOTIFICATION OF SANCTION**

**To: John MCPHEE, Rider No. 17 of the Moto3 Class**

Dear Sir,

According to Article 3.5.5 of the FIM World Championship Grand Prix Regulations, we confirm our decision with a hearing,

**Motive**

On 4 April 2021, at 17:31 after a crash at Turn 1 during the Moto3 Race of the TISSOT GRAND PRIX OF DOHA your found to be fighting with another rider.

- This contravenes Article 3.3.2.2 of the FIM World Championship Grand Prix Regulations “any corrupt or fraudulent act, or any action prejudicial to the interests of the meetings or of the sport, carried out by a person or a group of persons occurring during an event.” It is therefore an infringement of the FIM World Championship Grand Prix Regulations, being detrimental to the interests of the sport.

**Sanction**

For the above reasons, the FIM MotoGP Stewards Panel has imposed a Pit Lane Start that will be 10 seconds after a normal Pit Lane Start for the GRANDE PRÉMIO DE PORTUGAL Moto3 Race. There will also be a fine of 1000 Euro imposed. (in accordance with articles 3.2.1 and 3.3.2.3)

**Right of Appeal**


According to Article 3.4.2 of the FIM World Championship Grand Prix Regulations, there is a right to appeal against this decision to the FIM Appeal Stewards. A statement of appeal must be made within 1 hour from the time of this notification, accompanied by a security deposit of €1320. The appeal can be lodged with the FIM Stewards or IRTA, who may also arrange for guarantee of the security deposit.


